From Route 1 North or Route 1 South:

Take Harrison Street exit (if you are heading North this involves taking the jug-handle). At third light, make left onto Nassau Street. Go to the second light (Washington Road) and make a left.

From Washington Road, make the first left onto William Street. After passing Hoyt Laboratory, make a right into the first driveway. If there are no spaces available, park in the lot directly across William Street.

From Route 95, take Route 1 North exit (exit 67). Take Route 1 to Harrison Street exit and follow directions above.

From Route 27: Route 27 becomes Nassau Street. Take Nassau Street to Washington Rd. and follow directions above.
